CONTACT LENS INFORMATION AND POLICY

Contact lens evaluations are offered in addition to the routine eye exam for patients wishing to wear contact lenses.

There are additional fees for these services which may not be covered by your vision insurance. Fees are based on the complexity of the fitting:

- Tier 1 – Spherical Disposable Lenses: \$69
- Tier 2 – Toric (Astigmatism) Disposable Lenses: \$89
- Tier 3 – Multifocal or Monovision Disposable Lenses: \$109
- Tiers 4 & 5 – RGP and Specialty Lenses: \$129+

Contact lens prescriptions expire after one year; after that time you must have another routine eye exam and contact lens evaluation to obtain a new contact lens prescription. This ensures not only that your prescription is updated for the best possible vision, but also that your eyes are healthy enough to continue wearing contact lenses.

In some cases, a contact lens follow up appointment may be required prior to finalizing your prescription. We recommend scheduling this appointment 7-10 days after receiving your trial lenses to ensure the fitting process is completed in a timely manner. You may also request a follow up appointment if you have questions or concerns regarding your new lenses. If the fitting process is not completed within 60 days of initial evaluation, additional appointments will be subject to a re-fitting or re-examination fee.

First time contact lens wearers must complete a contact lens training class, during which they will learn insertion and removal techniques as well as proper contact lens care. There is a \$35 fee for this training class in addition to the evaluation fee.

All professional fees are due at the time of service and are non-refundable.
